

MINUTES

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Sullivan Township Board held at the Sullivan Township Hall, July 6, 2017.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Mabrito at 6:30 p.m. with the pledge of allegiance.

PRESENT: Supervisor, Tony Mabrito; Clerk, Sue Buckner; Treasurer, Tammy Gillette; Trustee, Trustee, Keith Patterson; six residents, and Muskegon County Drain Commissioner, Brenda Moore.

ABSENT: Trustee, Libby Spencer

MINUTES: It was moved by Tammy Gillette, supported by Keith Patterson, to accept the minutes of the regular meeting held June 6, 2017.

Motion carried.

FINANCE: The Treasurer's report on Township receipts of \$21,273.19 for the period of June 1, 2017, through June 30, 2017, was presented by Treasurer, Tammy Gillette.

It was moved by Sue Buckner, supported by Tammy Gillette, to pay bills of \$61,631.96 as presented by Clerk, Sue Buckner. Motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: Planning Commission: Minutes from the June 13, 2017 Joint Meeting were reviewed by PC Secretary, Eloise Jarka.

CORRESPONDENCE: Comments from Louis Jasick regarding the Chairman of the Park Committee were discussed.

OLD BUSINESS: Greater Muskegon Recreational Partnership – Tom Jasick advised that the Tiger Grant issue was a dead issue. Several questions were answered, by Tom, regarding the Articles of Incorporation of the Greater Muskegon Recreation Partnership. This issue was tabled until the August meeting as more information is needed to approve said agreement.

Sue Buckner to get quote from Acme Tree Service to have trees removed and trimmed, from the Township Park and Cemetery.

Volunteers are still needed for the Tire Recycle Event to be held on August 5, 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m., located behind the Egelston Township Hall. If interested in volunteering, please contact the business office at 231-853-6900.

Discussion regarding township park vandalism was reviewed and will continue at the August 1 Meeting.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION: Brenda Moore, Muskegon County Drain Commissioner discussed clean-up of Wooley Marsh and costs associated with it. Four residents spoke on this issue and recommended that the Township approve additional funds for this project.

Motion made by Sue Buckner, supported by Tammy Gillette, to approve Resolution to Authorize Spending Above the Maintenance Limit of the County Drain Code for the Wooley Marsh Drain. Motion carried.

Township residents can now pay their taxes at Choice One Bank locations in Ravenna and Egelston.

DISCUSSION: M.T.S Permits issued for May, 2017 were reviewed. The 10% rebate for permit cost to the township is \$237.70.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business to come before the Board, it was moved by Sue Buckner, supported by Keith Patterson to adjourn. Motion carried.
