Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Sullivan Township Board held at the Sullivan Township Hall, July 3, 2018.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Mabrito at 6:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL: Present: Supervisor, Tony Mabrito; Clerk, Sue Buckner; Treasurer, Tammy Gillette; Trustee, Libby Spencer; Trustee, Keith Patterson.

AGENDA: It was moved by Libby Spencer, supported by Tammy Gillette, to approve the agenda of today as presented. Motion carried.

MINUTES: It was moved by Libby Spencer, supported by Tammy Gillette, to accept the minutes of the regular meeting held June 5, 2018. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Zach Lahring introduced himself as a candidate for Muskegon County Commissioner, representing the 5<sup>th</sup> District.

Alan Jager introduced himself as a candidate for the 91<sup>st</sup> District State House Representative.

Several residents expressed their opinions/objections/concerns, regarding the Special Land Use Permit for sand mining on Summit Avenue.

FINANCE: The Treasurer's report on Township receipts of \$62,220.69 for the period of June 1, 2018, through June 30, 2018, was presented by Treasurer Tammy Gillette.

It was moved by Sue Buckner, supported by Tammy Gillette, to pay bills of \$64,938.63 as presented by Clerk Sue Buckner. Motion carried.

REPORTS:

1. Planning Commission: Eloise Jarka read the Minutes from the June 12, 2018 Meeting. Next Planning Commission Meeting is July 10, 2018 along with a Public Hearing for a Verizon Tower at 5960 Hts. Ravenna Rd.  
The Planning Commission recommended approval of Resolution for Denial of a Special Land Use Permit for the Commercial Removal of Sand located at 4740 East Summit Avenue. The applicant withdraw his application on June 29, 2018, negating this recommendation for vote.
2. Parks Sub-Committee: Recommendations include: Finish painting building, installation of crowns for ball diamond fence, trim all bushes, elimination of poison ivy by the ball field and walking trail.  
Brian Dodge will spray to kill the poison ivy. Next meeting is October 18, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.
3. MTS Permits: Not available.

CORRESPONDENCE:

1. Community Foundation Wish List – The Township submitted a request for funds, for a four seat, 10' heavy duty tripod swing set, in the amount of \$2,367.41.

OLD BUSINESS: Tammy Gillette submitted the necessary paperwork, to the State, for reimbursement of funds, used for the Township Tire Recycle Event.
